



## Protocol for the opening and use of Northampton Boat Club Bar.

### **The bar will only be open Saturday and Sunday lunch time initially**

- The club will operate a one-way system.
- Members may enter the toilets via the side door next to the diesel tank. But, must exit via the main clubhouse entrance. Following arrowed route.
- One member in the toilet at a time unless it is an emergency. Please ensure thorough hand washing is observed and use hand sanitiser provided.
- Members wishing to use the bar or sit in the clubhouse must enter via the rear double doors (Disabled Access) and follow arrowed directions.
- Please observe the 2metre distancing rule where possible.
- Members wishing to purchase drinks or snacks from the bar, must follow arrowed one-way system from the rear doors.
- Waiting 2m apart, until you reach the 1m bar serving area. Whilst you are waiting for your drink(s) members must write their full name and the names of people in their party in the Login book. This is for Track and Trace purposes should the need arise.
- We would like to keep handling money to a minimum, so members can have a 'tab' for the duration of their visit, but it must be paid via chip n pin before you leave. If you do not wish to use chip n pin cash can be used.
- When you have finished with your glasses, please place them in the dishwasher tray on the table by the bar door.
- Glasses will not be refilled, please only use once and get a fresh glass.
- Please sanitise your table before you leave with the spray and cloth provided.
- Bar staff will be wearing PPE for their protection and yours. The committee have volunteered to man the bar initially, and the Bar rota will be suspended,
- Any member who is willing to work a lunchtime session, please speak to a committee member or put a note in the post box by committee room.
